All items need to be covered this will be removed for judging and then put in a large clear bag which will be supplied.

Presentation will be added to scoring criteria so no restriction – paper plates no longer a requirement.

Points awarded for –

Uniformity (if more than one item)/evenness of bake

Degree of bake- not too light/dark, top/sides not caught, good colour, no bubbles, no cooling rack marks, same size throughout.

No soggy bottoms

Flavouring/filling evenly distributed

Biscuits need to snap

Meringues need to be the same – traditional, soft in the middle.

Decorated items will be judged on the bake as well but higher scoring on decoration.

Flavour

Jam/marmalade/chutney – jars should be plain (no remains of a previous label), well filled, dated and product identified ie strawberry jam. Cellophane/wax discs to be used, no clingfilm, screw top on chutney.

Drinks – clear bottle with screw top, dated and clearly identified, free from bits and sediment.
