Each competitor to pleach and peg the stated length (approx Half a chain, less for beginners) in 5 hours in the Dorset/Somerset style, bound with a natural tie, i.e. no wire or twine. Crooks or Bonds may be used. The height will be stated on the day.

Any competitor failing to complete the fence must complete it after the allotted time.

Competitors to observe safe working practices, including appropriate clothing if using chain saws and site tidiness, at all times.
