

#### **PROCEDURE**

- 5.1. Competitors will be required to produce an item of 'Metalwork' predominately metal and recycled items.
- 5.2. Size not to exceed 1 metre cubed; maximum weights limit of 15 kilograms; finished with exterior paint.
- 5.3. The competitor should pay particular attention to the standard of finish of their exhibit.
- 5.4. Materials used should be predominantly recycled to minimise cost and environmental impact.
- 5.5. Competitors must accept responsibility for transporting their exhibits to the final as per the instructions which will be issued and to make arrangements for collection of the exhibits after 5 pm. All exhibits must be removed on the day of the competition.
- 5.6. Prior to the competition, before commencement of any work on the item, members should be aware of potential health and safety risks and use all appropriate Personal Safety Equipment. The safety of people viewing and touching the finished item should also be considered, eg: avoid sharp edges.
- 5.7. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitors. Competitors must make themselves available throughout the judging to answer the Judges questions and explain the processes behind the production of the item.
- 5.8. A story board containing pictures should accompany the exhibit.

- Ladies and Men's teams shall consist of eight pulling members of the same gender. No more than two (2) members of a team may be between the ages of 15 and over, and under 17 years on 1 September 2022 and the remainder of the team MUST be between 17 years and over, and 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2022.
- A Junior GENSB team shall consist of between 7 and 10 pulling members, male or female, who must be between 12 years & 17 years of age and under on 1st September 2022. This means competitors MUST have attained their 12th birthday on 1st September 2022 and may be 18 on the day of the competition.

#### Full Day Auto Test – (28 & under)

Competitors (the Club Team) to be 28 years of age or under on 1 September 2022 and a full member of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC. The person driving on the day must provide their FULL Driving Licence on booking in. The team can consist of either 2 Senior Members or 2 Inter Members (or mixed) or A Senior or Inter Member driving and a junior navigator.

Each Club can have a maximum of 2 teams.

The competition is to navigate through a marked course not hitting any of the circuit and being timed

#### **Morning Competitions**

#### From 9.30 am - 12.30pm

1. **Senior Tractor** - **Individual** Competitors must be 22 – 28 years. Teams of two, the first competitor must manoeuvre a trailer through a course and unhitch. The Second competitor has to attach a three point linkage implement and manoeuvre through a course, the implement must then be detached, and hitch up the trailer to finish. The course will be designed by the judge. Judged by quickest time.

- 2. Intermediate Tractor Individual Competitors must be 18 21 years. Teams of two, the first competitor must manoeuvre a trailer through a course and unhitch. The Second competitor has to attach a three point linkage implement and manoeuvre through a course, the implement must then be detached, and hitch up the trailer to finish. The course will be designed by the judged. Judge by quickest time.
- 3. **Junior Tractor Individual** Competitors must be 14 17 years and are required to negotiate a course set by the judge. Judged by quickest time.
- **4. ATV Open Team** A team shall consist of two members, one shall be 21 years or under on the 1st of September 2022 and the other member shall be 28 years or under on the 1st September 2022. The course will be set by the judge. Judged by quickest time.
- **5. Telehandler Open Individual** Full UK Driving licence required. Competitors are required to negotiate the course set by the judge. Judged by quickest time.
- **6. Mini Digger Hook a duck-** Open Individual Full UK Driving licence holders only judged by quickest time.
- 7. Load and strap down (Ratchet) a trailer of conventional bales Open Individual Competitors must be 10 28 years. Judged by quickest time.
- **8.** Make a double bed Open Individual Competitors must be 10 28 years. Judged by quickest time and the neatest bed.
- 9. Reel an electric tape up Open Individual Competitors must be 10 28 years. Judged by quickest time and the neatest.
- 10. Nail bashing and removal of nail Open Individual Competitors must be 10-28 years. Judged by quickest time.
- **11. Welly Wanging Open Individual** Competitors must be 10 28 years. judged by furthest distance thrown.
- **12.** Carnival float Club Entry can be assembled on any vehicle/base any size for the entry judged by Mike Tizzard County President.

Results of the Dorset YFC Calf Show Competition will be displayed on the day with the Handicraft and Cookery entries you can view these at 1.30pm. Presentation of awards will take place prior to the Rally Results at the end of the day. This competition was kindly organised by Marshwood Vale YFC and Judged by Mr Phil Bird

#### **Cookery Competitions**

#### Judge: Shirley Warr & another TBC

Entries need to be in the marquee for judging by 10am (open 9.00am – 10.00am).

#### Ingredients for Marble Cake

- 175g/6oz butter or baking spread
  - 175g/6oz caster sugar
- 3 free-range eggs, lightly beaten
- ½ tsp vanilla extract
- 225g/8oz self-raising flour
- pinch salt
- 2 tbsp milk
- 2 tbsp cocoa powder
- 2 tbsp strong black coffee, cooled

#### Recipe tips

#### Method

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180C/160C Fan/Gas 4. Grease and line a 900g/2lb loaf tin or 20cm/8in round tin.
- 2. Cream the butter and sugar with an electric whisk in a large mixing bowl until very pale and fluffy. Add the beaten egg, a little at a time, whisking well after each addition. Then whisk in the vanilla extract.
- 3. Sift the flour and salt into a large bowl, then fold it gently into the butter and egg mixture.
- 4. Divide the cake batter into two equal portions (about 350g each).
- 5. Add the milk to one portion of the mixture, stirring in gently until well combined.
- 6. Mix the cocoa powder and the coffee together in a mug to form a smooth paste. Stir this paste into the other portion of the cake batter until thoroughly combined.
- 7. Spoon large blobs of each cake mixture into the prepared tin, alternating the flavours to give a marble effect. Bake for 50–60 minutes until the cake is springy to the touch and a wooden skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean.
- 8. Allow the cake to cool in the tin for 10 minutes, then turn out onto a wire rack and cool completely before slicing.

#### **Ingredients for Cherry Cake Loaf**

- 200g/7oz natural coloured glacé cherries
- 1 tbsp plain flour
- 200g/7oz unsalted butter, softened, plus extra for greasing tin
- 175g/6oz caster sugar, plus 1½ tbsp
- 4 free-range eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla extract or almond extract
- 1 tsp finely grated lemon zest
- 250g/9oz self-raising flour
- 1½ tsp baking powder
- pinch salt
- 75g/2½oz ground almonds
- 2 tbsp milk
- 25g/1oz flaked almonds

#### Method

- 1. Preheat the oven to 170C/160C Fan/Gas 3½. Grease and line a 900g/2lb loaf tin (approximately 13x23cm/5x9in) with baking paper.
- 2. Cut the cherries in half, tip into a sieve and rinse well under warm water to remove the sticky syrup. Dry well on kitchen paper and tip the cherries into a bowl, add the plain flour, mix well to coat and set aside.
- 3. Cream together the softened butter and 175g/6oz caster sugar until really pale and light. This will take 3–4 minutes and is quicker and easier using a freestanding mixer but an electric hand whisk also works well. Add the eggs, one at a time and mix well between each addition.
- 4. Add the vanilla extract and lemon zest and mix again to combine.
- 5. Sift the flour, baking powder and a pinch of salt into the bowl, add the ground almonds and milk and beat until smooth and thoroughly combined.
- 6. Fold the cherries into the mixture and spoon into the prepared loaf tin. Spread level with the back of a spoon, sprinkle with the remaining caster sugar and scatter with the flaked almonds. Bake on the middle shelf of the preheated oven for 1 hour until the cake is golden-brown, well-risen and a skewer inserted into the middle of the cake comes out clean. If the cake is browning too quickly loosely cover the top with a sheet of foil for the last 15 minutes.
- 7. Leave the cake to cool in the tin for 10 minutes and then carefully lift out onto a cooling rack and leave until cold before slicing.

#### Ingredients for Chocolate Swiss Roll

- 60g self-raising flour
- 3 tbsp cocoa powder
- 3 eggs
- 75g golden caster sugar, plus extra for scattering

#### For the filling

- 200ml double cream
- ½ tsp vanilla extract
- 50g icing sugar, sifted, plus extra to serve

#### **Method**

- STEP 1- Heat the oven to 220C/200C fan/gas 7. Line a 22 x 32cm swiss roll tin (if it's 20 x 30cm that's still fine) with baking parchment. Sift the flour and cocoa powder together into a bowl and set aside.
- STEP 2- Crack the eggs into another bowl or the bowl of a stand mixer and tip in the sugar. Use an electric whisk or the whisk attachment to beat the eggs and sugar together for 5 mins until pale and very thick. Use a spoon or spatula to gently fold in the flour mixture until completely incorporated and everything's the same colour with no streaks.
- STEP 3- Gently scrape the mix into the tin and spread to the corners. Bake for 9-10 mins until puffed up and springy to touch. While the cake is baking, get another piece of parchment a little larger than the tin and scatter it with sugar. When the sponge is cooked, use oven gloves to carefully invert it onto the sugar-coated paper. Lift off the tin and peel away the top layer of parchment. Score a line 2cm from one of the shorter edges, then use the parchment to roll the sponge into a spiral with the parchment running through it. Leave the rolled sponge to cool completely.
- **STEP 4-** While the cake is cooling, make the filling by whisking all the ingredients together until the cream stiffens. Unroll the sponge and spread over the filling, leaving the scored edge clear. Starting from the scored edge, use the parchment to roll the sponge up around the filling. Lift onto a board or serving platter and dust with icing sugar. Can be served straight away or chilled for up to 24 hrs. Serve in slices.

#### **DISPLAYING ALL COMPETITION ENTRIES** - please read carefully

All handicraft and practical competitions must be entered for prior to the event to enable ease of scoring. Members must provide a current membership card on arrival for Exhibit Cards. All entries to be presented on a paper plate or cake board and covered with cling film, unless otherwise stated, this will be taken off for judging and replaced after.

Please place your name, membership number and class number on a label at the BOTTOM of the exhibit so it can't be viewed by the judges.

Points awarded for -

- Uniformity (if more than one item)/evenness of bake
- Degree of bake- not too light/dark, top/sides not caught, good colour, no bubbles, no cooling rack marks, same size throughout.
- No soggy bottoms
- Flavouring/filling evenly distributed
- Decorated items will be judged on the bake as well but higher scoring on decoration.
- Flavour
- Drinks clear bottle with screw top, dated and clearly identified, free from bits and sediment.

Please note ALL items must be collected before the end of the day (5.00pm approx.), after this time the items will be destroyed.
